

America's Cup Invitational Rules

IWWF rules will be followed for the America's Cup Invitational. Run offs for the last qualifying position into the finals for men's slalom will use the following rules. The top seeded skier will pick if they ski first or second, the skier that skis second must beat the first skier in order to advance. Men's jumping will follow IWWF tie rule with the exception that the higher seeded skier will select if he will ski first or second. The America's Cup Invitational will accept the top four as determined by placement in the 76th GOODE Water Ski National Championships in all other events. Skiers not on the IWWF list will be seeded by AWSA list.

America's Cup Invitational placements will be determined using the FINALS only. First place is the only placement that will be run off. All other ties will remain a tie and any placement money will be split. Run offs for first place in the finals will follow IWWF rules, which includes a random draw for order.
