

## **National Barefoot Record Procedure**

### **General Procedures:**

In order to qualify for a National Barefoot record, the tournament must be sanctioned as an RC event.

All potential records should be reviewed for verification on site by a committee of qualified judges before forwarding to the National Records Coordinator and Webmaster.

The preferred video formats are listed below in order of preference:

- 1) AVI file in 720 or 640 X 480 resolutions.
- 2) MPEG1 format
- 3) Send any media format (Mini DV, Super 8 DV, Super 8 or VHS tape.)

All required information should be sent within 14 days of the event.

All score sheets and dossiers can be scanned or digitally photographed and emailed as a JPEG file or sent through traditional mail.

The following information must be collected and sent to the National Records Coordinator and Webmaster:

### **National Slalom and Trick Record Procedures:**

- 1) Send one of the video formats listed above to both **Joe Malenfant and Gary Butler.**
- 2) Send all the boat score sheets, signed by the event judges to **Joe Malenfant.**
- 3) Send the pending National Record Dossier, signed by the event judges, to **Joe Malenfant.**

### **National Video Jump Record Procedures:**

- 1) Ensure a correct video jump setup is required. Please follow the "Video Jump Setup System Guide"
- 2) Send the bitmap (.bmp) file for the skier and the course. The images must have all 4 four buoys in it, to both **Joe Malenfant and Gary Butler .**
- 3) Send the survey setup file (.ipt), to both **Joe Malenfant and Gary Butler.**
- 4) Send the boat score sheet and the master recording sheet signed to **Joe Malenfant.**
