

IWSF/WBC World Record Approval Process

It is the responsibility of the Chief Judge for a record capability tournament to insure all documentation necessary for approval of a world record by the World Barefoot Council is submitted in a timely manner.

Please refer to Rule C17 if you have any questions not covered by the approval application.

A copy of the judges' forms and a copy of the Application for World Record must be sent within one week to the Chairman of the Group 1 Council and the ABC President. These addresses are provided for you below.

Further, a copy of the videotape of the record performance must be sent within one week to the Chairman of Group 1. Please send copies of the record performance only. Do not include other skier's performances on this tape. Keep the originals of the forms and tapes -- DO NOT DESTROY.

Important points from the Application for World Record:

- All judges must review the video before it is sent in (they must still agree that it is a record performance)
- The Homologator and Chief Judge must review the record claim for accuracy and validity
- For any exceptions, an explanation must be included (this includes missing the seven day deadline for submission)
- If any information is missing, the application will be rejected, possibly cost a skier a chance at a World Record
- For a jump record, all parameters from Rule C1706(c) must be listed

Some hints to help you comply with the rules set out in Rule C17:

- Open events should not be scheduled for the last event on Sunday. This makes the required review by the event judges and homologator next to impossible.
- As soon as you suspect that a record has been broken, the videotape should be pulled and the event judges gathered to look at the tape.
- It should be made clear to event judges selected for the Open event that part of their duty is to review the video tape after the event. They cannot leave the site until this has been done.
- You should fill out forms before the tournament starts and have them ready in case a record is set.
- All paperwork should be done before you leave the site.
