

Individual Event Entry Procedure:

Should the previous year's Champion(s) choose to enter in defense of their title, Entries for the 2011 National Show Ski Tournament Individual Event Competition – Division I will be limited to 15 individuals in the swivel, 15 teams in the multi-jump, 15 individuals in freestyle jump, and 15 pairs for the doubles competition (14 each for Division II). Should the previous year's Champion's not enter, the events will be limited to 14 competitors each. Individuals selected to compete will be notified by August 1, 2011. The following formula will be used to select all skiers who will compete provided all entry requirements have been met:

1. The previous year's champion will be invited, seeded first and ski last. **(Division I ONLY)**
Should both partners of the previous year's Doubles Champions be unable to compete in defense of their title, they will NOT be entered in this year's National Show Ski Championships Tournament as the defending champion.
2. The top qualifiers from each region in each individual event (7 max.) will be seeded via the Regional Tournament results / random drawing if no Regional Tournament held and ski the 8th – 14th Slots. OR by the rotation as per #4 below.
3. The second highest qualifiers from each region will be seeded via a random drawing and ski 1st - 7th slots. OR by the rotation as per #4 below.
4. Should each region NOT select two qualifiers, the 1st – 7th slots will be filled via the following rotation (and then repeated, until a total of 15 / 14 contestants are selected respectfully): Wisconsin, Southern, Central, Midwest, Eastern, South Central, West.
- 5-a. The entry fee for the 2011 National Show Ski Tournament - **Division I Individual Event Competition** is: **\$75.00**. Please make all checks **payable to the Rock Aqua Jays**
- 5-b. The entry fee for the 2011 National Show Ski Tournament - **Division II Individual Event Competition** is: **\$60.00**. Please make all checks payable to the **Kwahamot Water Ski Club**
6. All entries should be sent via **US Certified Mail by midnight CDT, July 15, 2011 - EXEMPTIONS to this date are explained in Chapters 5 & 6 - 2004 NSSA P&P Manual (Revised)**
Entry fee will be returned if not chosen to represent your Region.
7. **A music list and proof of USAWS membership should accompany each entry form, along with number of specified copies of the Swivel & Doubles Trick Lists. This information MUST be provided at registration.**
8. All skiers, pin-persons and boat drivers must provide a photocopy or original of USA-WS membership card at registration or with application.

10. In the event any part of a doubles team is physically unable to compete, a substitute may enter without qualifying with the approval of Regional Director(s). If the petition to use a substitute is granted, the National Tournament Chairman MUST be notified no later than the conclusion of the Registration for Individual Event Competition at that year's National Tournament Site. Filling of Empty Slots or Replacing Late Withdrawal(s) from Competition:

Should an opening occur in either Individual Event competition or Team Event Competition due to the late withdrawal (after Running Orders are Published) of a Qualified / Seeded Competitor the National

Tournament(s) Chairman will contact the first eligible Entrant from the same Region who was not Seeded through the normal process and offer the opportunity to compete. If the opportunity is declined, the National Tournament(s) Chairman will repeat this process within that Region until all eligible entrants are exhausted. Should the opening still exist, the Chairman will then revert to the original Regional Rotation procedure contacting the first eligible Entrant from each Region until the openings is filled (repeating as many times as is necessary or until all eligible entrants are exhausted).

The National Tournament(s) Chairman will execute this process until the close of the Registration Period for the Event Competition – Individual & Team at each respective National Show Ski Tournament (Division I & II).
